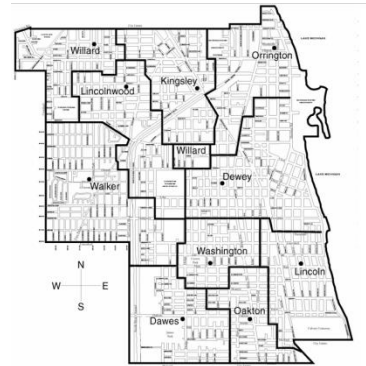
About Foundation 65

About Evanston-Skokie School District 65

Evanston-Skokie School District 65 covers all of Evanston and a small part of Skokie. The District consists of 10 attendance area elementary schools (grades K-5); three attendance area middle schools (grades 6-8); two magnet schools (grades K-8); an early childhood center; and a school for students with special needs. All District 65 students are taught by highly qualified educators and utilize the same curriculum and instructional materials.

About Evanston

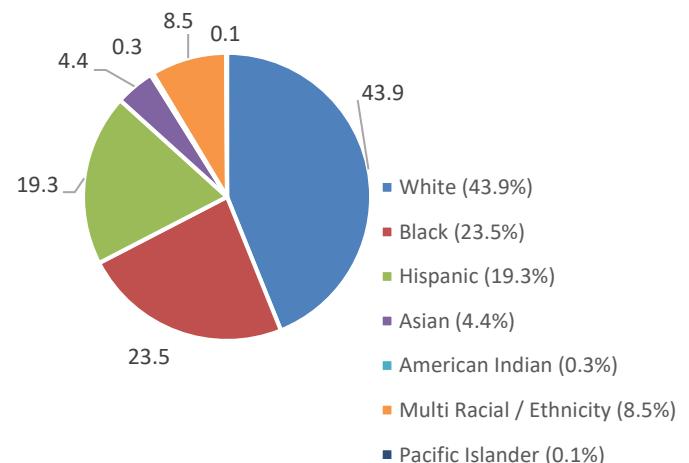
Located in Cook County, Evanston borders Lake Michigan to the east, Chicago to the south, Skokie to the west, and Wilmette to the north. Evanston is a diverse community with a vibrant and unique downtown district, rich theater and arts community and home to Northwestern University.

Demographics and Racial/Ethnic Diversity

As of the census of 2010, there were 74,486 people in 30,047 households residing in Evanston. The 2010 census showed that Evanston is ethnically mixed with the following breakdown in population: 65.6% White, 18.1% Black or African American, 0.2% American Indian or Alaska Native, 8.6% Asian, 0.02% Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, 3.6% some other race, and 3.8% from two or more races. 9.0% were Hispanic or Latino of any race.

26.1% of households had children under the age of 18 living with them. As of 2011, the estimated median income for a household was \$60,033. About 12.1% of the population were below the poverty line, including 14.1% of those under age 18 and 6.5% of those age 65 or over.
